Dear MACTLAC Member:

The enclosed information concerns the seventeenth annual MACTLAC meeting to be held October 10-11 at Elmhurst College, Elmhurst, Illinois. On surveying the meeting program you will see that Rudolph Priepke, local program chairman, and his staff have planned interesting sessions. The printed program is self-explanatory, but let me point out that the meeting offers both the opportunity to hear three excellent speakers and the opportunity to share experiences in ten different discussion groups covering a wide range of interests.

Please note a slight departure from the traditional Saturday morning schedule. The general business meeting will follow Dr. Lykos' presentation on computers. The time after the business meeting is "free" for the continuation of some of the Friday discussion sessions, for the repeat of some of the Friday sessions, or for new sessions generated by mutual interest.

The enclosed envelope allows for preregistration and dues payment. We hope that all members will cooperate in this way as soon as plans are clear. Prepayment greatly simplifies the registration procedure when you arrive. Even if you are reluctant to enclose payment for fear of changing plans, the staff would still appreciate receiving your return envelope filled out with an indication of your probable plans. The central location and accessibility of Elmhurst lead to a large predicted attendance at the meeting, so please avoid straining the Elmhurst staff with last minute reservations. As noted below, a block of motel rooms is being reserved until September 25.

The current dues are \$1.00 and the registration fee is \$1.00. The registration fee is used to aid the host school in obtaining special speakers. The Friday evening meal will be \$3.50. Thus full participation involves \$5.50 plus any back dues. Please note that, contrary to the usual tradition, you will be on your own for the Saturday luncheon. As indicated in the printed program, the College Union Cafeteria is available Friday noon and Saturday morning and noon.

Information on transportation and housing may be found in the Elmhurst College Campus Guide. In addition to O'Hare Field and the interstate highway system, Elmhurst is served by hourly commuter train service from the "Loop". A block of rooms is being held for MACTLAC at the Elmhurst Holiday Inn (near the intersection of York Street and Highway 20) until September 25. The Elmhurst Holiday Inn offers limousine connections with O'Hare Field. All lodging accommodations should be arranged for by direct contact with the motel of your choice.

Circle October 10-11 on your calendar and plan to come to Elmhurst to renew old MACTLAC acquaintances and make new ones, and to participate in what the Elmhurst staff hopes you will find to be "one of the best meetings ever".
