

Laboratory Safety Short Course

There is a possibility of having a short course on lab safety in conjunction with the 1981 MACTLAC meeting at Carthage College. The course would be taught by Norman Steere who is well-known as a consultant on lab safety. The course would run for 1 day or 1 1/2 days immediately before or after the MACTLAC meeting. There would be a charge of probably \$25.00 to \$50.00 and there would need to be a minimum of 25 participants. The Executive Council of MACTLAC feels this is potentially a good opportunity for MACTLAC members--the course would be geared specifically to the problems of safety in undergraduate colleges; it would be less expensive than most safety short courses; and there would be no extra travel expense.
