A block of rooms has been reserved at the Holiday Inn South, 9455 Bloomington Freeway, Minneapolis. Please make reservations with the motel before October 1, and specify that you are a MACTLAC member. If you would be willing to share a double with another participant, please include that with your request. The toll-free reservation number for all Holiday Inns is 1-800-621-5511.

Chartered buses will be provided at a total cost of about \$5 for two round trips between the motel and Northfield. Depending on arrival times, one will leave the motel Friday about 11 and another about 12:15. They will return after the evening program and will again come to Northfield in time for the opening session Saturday. Transportation on the buses to the airport will be available immediately after lunch. If enough flights go earlier, a bus may go up earlier.
