With regard to a summary of the previous year's activities in the teacher placement service, I am glad once again to give you some statistics concerning what has happened in this regard. The easiest way to summarize them is according to the following table:

You will see that the numbers are quite drastically different from other years with many more applicants corresponding with us and somewhat fewer positions being made known to us.
