PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION

The executive council on Oct. 27, 1955 voted unanimously to amend Sec. 3, Article V, of the constitution to read: "Each state shall elect its representative by nomination and vote of its own group of members present at the annual business meeting. On even-numbered years four council members are to be elected and on odd-numbered years three members are to be elected. The amendment is essentially the second sentence of the above statement. According to Article VI, Sections 2 and 3, a proposed amendment must be circulated to all members along with the notices of the annual meeting. If no more than 10% of the members file written objections at least 10 days before the annual meeting and if a majority of those present at the annual meeting approve, the amendment shall be adopted.

The above amendment was proposed to increase the continuity of service of the executive council.

DELINQUENT DUES.

It was the unanimous recommendation of the executive council that members with dues in arrears several years shall be dropped from the membership.
