
Clinton Rila reported about the two discussion groups devoted to the concerns of very small (one and two person) chemistry departments. Both groups had good attendance and lively, enthusiastic discussions. Discussion by the Council was very favorable to continue with similar discussion groups at next year's meeting. The Council accepted Clinton's suggestion that Dale Hugo be designated as co-chair of this Small Department Committee. Fifty dollars was again approved to use for mailing costs.

Larry Funck asked about MACTLAC's role in political action. Should we lobby? Some political action has been done in the past. It was agreed that the Council should return to this issue next year.

It was observed that MACTLAC meetings are not attracting younger faculty members, a serious problem. How can we get them to the meeting? One suggestion was a grant writing workshop.
