A conference of college chemistry teachers will be held on the Monmouth College campus, Friday and Saturday, November 14 and 15, 1952. This is being sponsored by Monmouth College as one of the major events of its Centennial Year. College chemistry teachers in liberal arts colleges in Illinois and adjacent states have been invited to participate.

Edward L. Haenisch, professor of chemistry and chairman of the department, Wabash College, will be the director of the conference. Speakers will include Alfred B. Garrett, professor of chemistry, The Ohio State University, Harry P. Lewis, dean of The Institute of Paper Chemistry and S.H. Volwiler, president and general manager, Abbott Laboratories. Time is provided in the conference program for meetings of the participants in small groups for discussion of common problems.
