It has occurred to me that you might be interested in the following as a new item for the education section of the New York Times.

A conference of college chemistry teachers will be held on the Vermont campus, Friday and Saturday, November 18 and 19, 1938. This is being sponsored by Vermont College as one of the major events of its Centennial Year. College chemistry teachers in liberal arts colleges in Illinois and adjacent states have been invited to participate.

Edward E. Haenisch, professor of chemistry and chairman of the department, Sabash College, will be the director of the conference. Speakers will include Alfred Garrett, professor of chemistry, The Ohio State University, Harry F. Lewis, dean, The Institute of Paper Chemistry, and S. H. Volwiler, president and general manager, Abbott Laboratories. Time is provided in the conference program for meetings of participants in small groups for discussion of common problems.
