Travel Information

Alma is on U.S. 27 a four lane divided freeway most of the distance. It intersects the Interstate 96 freeway at Marshall. Coming from Chicago and west, route 35 is a good way to cross over from the Indiana Toll Road, leaving it at LaPorte and crossing U.S. 12 and Interstate 96 at New Buffalo, Michigan.

Coming from the south, the first Alma exit from the freeway is the Lincoln Road exit and by proceeding west Lincoln Road becomes Superior Street inside the city and the Alma campus is on Superior on the west side of town. For those who come by Lake Michigan Ferry or the Mackinac Bridge, arriving by U.S. 27 from the north, the first exit they will find for Alma is the Alger Road exit. Alger Road becomes Wright Avenue within the city and two miles from the exit comes to a dead end at Superior Street. The college is two blocks west of this corner.

Alma is easily reached by automobile, but rather difficult otherwise. Those who fly in should land at either Midland ("Tri-City") airport or Lansing airport. And communicate to Mr. Howard Potter, Alma College, in advance the scheduled time of arrival (and which airport) so that the Student Affiliates-A.C.S., Alma Chapter can provide transportation from the airport to the College.
