Dear John:

Thank you for your letter of September 30, 1970.

I will not be able to attend the Meeting of the Executive Council on Friday morning. October 9, but I am sending you herewith information on the previous year's activities of the MACTLAC Teacher Placement Directory.

The statistics may be summarized in the way similar to what I have done in previous years as follows:

Field of Chemistry	<u>Applicants</u>	Positions
Analytical	17	1
Biochemistry	17	2
General	22	1
Inorganic	49	2
Organic	83	1
Physical	72	3
TOTALS	260	10

Of the applicants listed, forty-three of them informed me that they obtained positions, although apparently only seven received positions as a result of the information from this office. You can see that the numbers of applicants have increased markedly and the number of positions is down significantly from last year.

Thank you again for your comments regarding the usefulness of this service. During the past year, we have simplified our method of responding to applicants and colleges. Basically what we did was to inform each applicant of every opening, regardless of the nature of the opening by field. This reduced considerably the amount of work involved, since it was not necessary to categorize openings and candidates by fields nor was it necessary to obtain resumes from them. If such a simplified treatment is satisfactory, I would be willing to continue in this activity for another year if MACTLAC wishes to continue it as one of their activities.

I am planning to be at the Calvin College Conference, although I will not get there until time for the afternoon session to start on Friday. If there is any additional information that I can give you at that time I would of course be very glad to do so.
