There will be a meeting of the committee at 5:15 P.M., Monday evening, September 7 in connection with the Chicago meeting of the American Chemical Society. I suggest that we gather in the basement lobby of the Conrad Hilton Hotel near the entrance to the exhibition hall where the registration area will be.

On the agenda are the following:

- (1) Program and arrangements for the fall meeting at Appleton, Wisconsin on Oct. 16 and 17. Dean Harry F. Lewis will meet with us. Cards have been sent to all who were in attendance at Monmouth last November, advising them of the date and stating that details will be sent out around Sept. 15
- (2) Formulation of a constitution for submission to the conference in October. There was such a diversity of replies to my query last December about qualifications for membership that we will have to thrash this matter out in committee session
- (3) Consideration of use of the JOURNAL OF CHEMICAL EDUCATION as a possible official organ for the Midwestern Association as it is already for the New England and Pacific organizations. Preliminary correspondence has already been carried on with Editor Wakestraw.
- (4) Plans for carrying out the survey of chemical industry to determine whether various companies might not consider some special type of support for small research projects to be carried out by the staffs of the liberal arts colleges on subjects either of the companies choosing or projects of interest to the college. ACC secretary Alden Emery has dumped a request for the Society to undertake this right back into our laps.

I hope that you can be with us for this meeting. It will be a vital one for the future success of the Midwestern Association
