It has occurred to me that you might be interested in the following as a news item for The Journal of Higher Education.

A conference of college chemistry teachers will be held on the Monmouth campus, Friday and Saturday, November 14 and 15, 1952. This is being sponsored by Monmouth College as one of the major events of its Centennial Year. College chemistry teachers in liberal arts colleges in Illinois and adjacent states have been invited to participate.

Edward L. Haenisch, professor of chemistry and chairman of the department, Monmouth College, will be the director of the conference. Speakers will include Alfred Garrett, professor of chemistry, The Ohio State University, Harry F. Lewis, dean, The Institute of Paper Chemistry and A. A.
